“Plagiarism means to present, as one’s own, the work, writing, words, ideas or computer information of someone else. (Sources could be published or unpublished.) Cheating is supplying, receiving or using devices (examples: looking at/using someone else’s work; using crib notes/stolen notes; or using disallowed equipment, etc.).
