



New Concurrent Enrollment Opportunities at Thornton HS 2020-2021



What is concurrent enrollment?

Concurrent Enrollment allows public high school students in grades 9-12 to take college classes for high school and college credit with tuition paid by the school district and the College Opportunity Fund. Students must pass the class with 70% or higher to earn college credit.

MAT 120 Math for the Liberal Arts

Must earn a qualifying score on Accuplacer or PSAT/SAT

Highlights connections between mathematics and the society in which we live.

MAT 121 College Algebra

Must earn a qualifying score on Accuplacer or PSAT/SAT

Focuses on a variety of functions and the exploration of their graphs. Topics include: equations and inequalities, operations on functions, exponential and logarithmic functions, linear and non-linear systems, and an introduction to conic sections. This course provides essential skills for STEM pathways. This is a statewide guaranteed transfer course in the GT-MA1 category.

Students will take Math Analysis first semester and take MAT 121 second semester.

This course will be taught by Ms. Ludwig and/or Mr. Pearson.



MUS 120 Music Appreciation

Introduces the study of music focusing on intelligent listening skills, the elements of music and their relationships, the musical characteristics of representative works and composers, common musical forms and genres of various Western, and non-Western historical style periods. This is a statewide Guaranteed Transfer course in the GT-AH1 category.

Students will take a THS Music Fundamentals Class first semester and MUS 120 second semester.

This course will be taught by Dr. Alley.



PSY 101 General Psychology 1

Focuses on the scientific study of behavior including motivation, emotion, physiological psychology, stress and coping, research methods, consciousness, sensation, perception, learning and memory. This is a statewide guaranteed course in the GT-SS3 category.

This is a one semester course
